1. Report from the evaluation of the courses and teaching of the Faculty of Islamic Studies

The Dean's Office of the Faculty of Islamic Studies, through the Quality Coordinator of FSI, has distributed questionnaires for the evaluation of subjects and teachers in the Faculty of Islamic Studies. Based on the questionnaires for the evaluation of subjects and teachers, which were completed by the students, the evaluation report was compiled. The evaluation report was compiled by the Quality Assurance Officer of the Faculty of Islamic Studies, and this report contains all relevant data such as: Average evaluation of courses and teachers at the program level; the average of the teacher and the courses; Assessment of reliability.

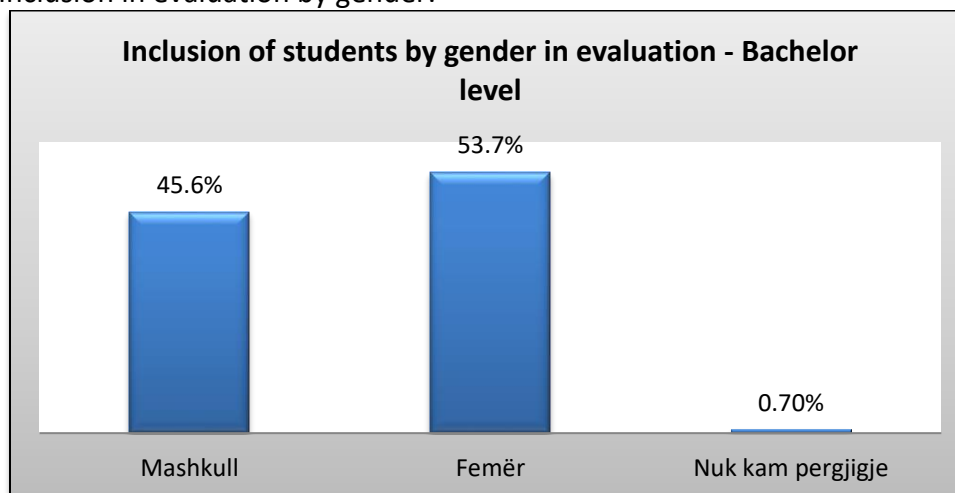

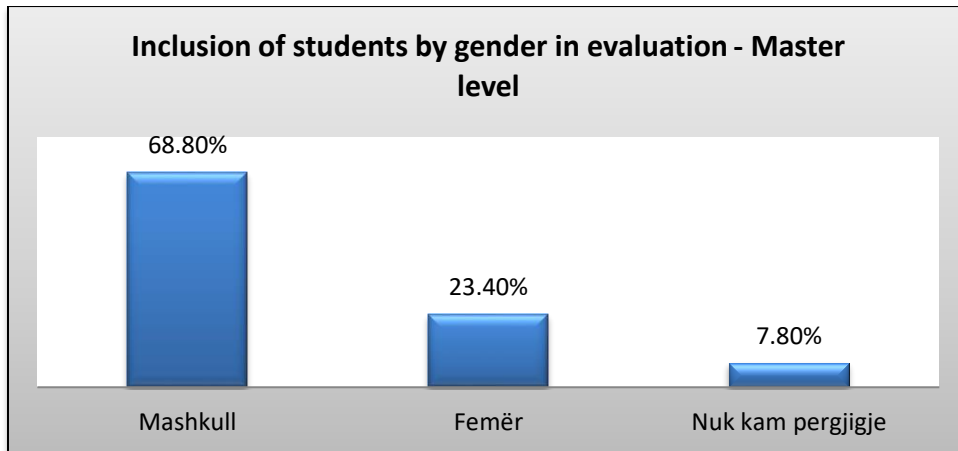
2. Average evaluation of courses and teachers at the program level

During the academic year 2023/2024 of the winter semester, 2 study programs were evaluated at the Faculty of Islamic Studies. Including the first, third, fifth and seventh semesters at the Bachelor's level of study. 298 students participated in the evaluation, while at the Master's level of studies, 64 students of the first semester participated. Besides the fact that there were questions about the performance of teachers and courses, there was also interest in the data on gender participation in the assessment.

Inclusion in evaluation by gender:



45.6% of male students participated in the evaluation and 53.7% of female students participated in the evaluation of professors and courses at the Bachelor level of studies. Whereas, 1% of students have not declared their gender.

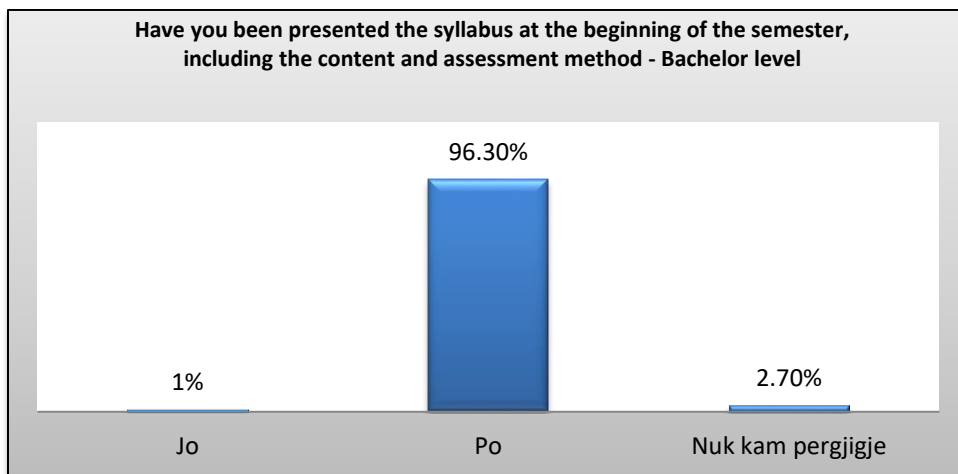


In master level of studies, 69% of male students participated in the evaluation and Bachelor level of studies, 23% of female of students participated in evaluation. While, 8% of students has not been declared for gender.

If we compare the inclusion of students by gender at the Bachelor and Master level, it can be seen that at the Bachelor level of studies there is greater inclusion in the evaluation of the female gender compared to the male gender. While at the Master's level of studies, it is the opposite.

Also, one of the issues of great interest for the Faculty of Islamic Studies is the collection of information for the distribution of the syllabus by professors to students.

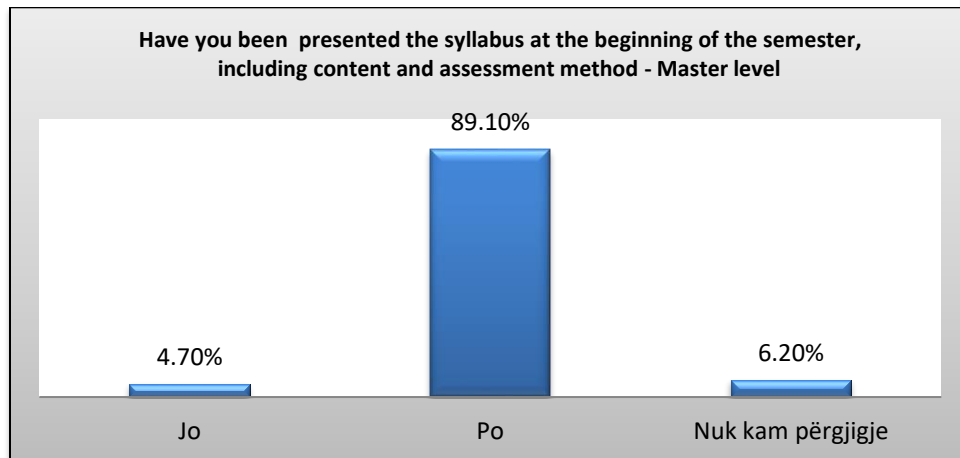
In the question of whether the syllabus was distributed to the students at the beginning of the semester, the answers were as follows:



The assessment shows that at the Bachelor level of study, 96% of students answered the Yes option, while only 1% answered No. 3% of the students who participated in the assessment did not answer this question.

This assessment can be considered as a good assessment and it can be concluded that the

academic staff distributed the syllabus at the beginning of the semester. This also reflects the work of the management that has to do with sensitizing the academic staff about the importance of distributing the syllabus at the beginning of the semester.



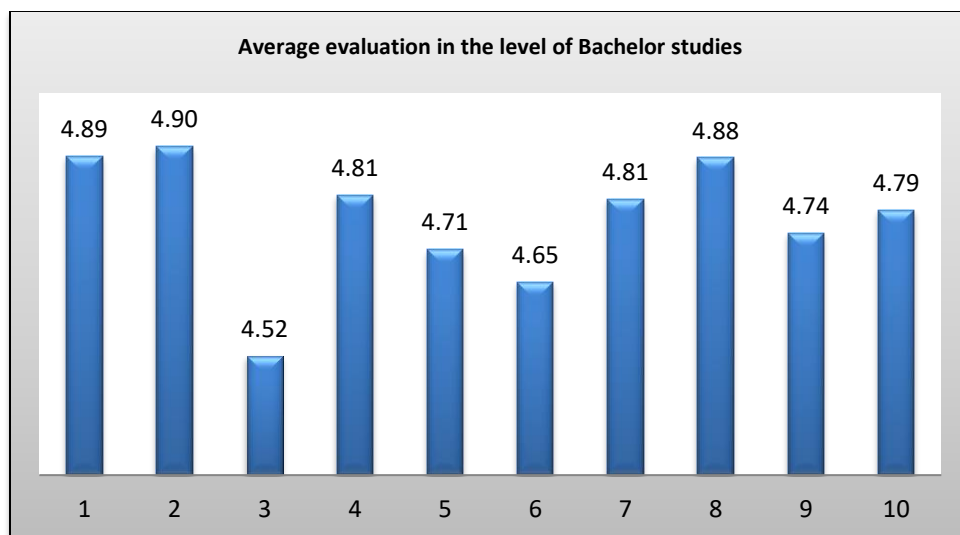
At the Master's level of studies, 89% of students answered the Yes option to the question “Have you been presented the syllabus at the beginning of the semester, including the content and assessment method, while 5% of students expressed No to the relevant question and 6% did not answer.

Although the majority of students have given positive answers, the management of the Faculty has to look into the reason why 5% of students gave a negative assessment and to improve this issue.

From the total number of respondents in the Faculty of Islamic Studies, at the Bachelor level of studies, the level of compliance of students varies between 4.52 and 4.90. These values indicate a high average agreement of students on the quality of the course and teaching performance at the program level.

The values generated in the figure below show the average compliance of the students for each question in the questionnaires by abstracting the individual evaluations of the Professors in particular.

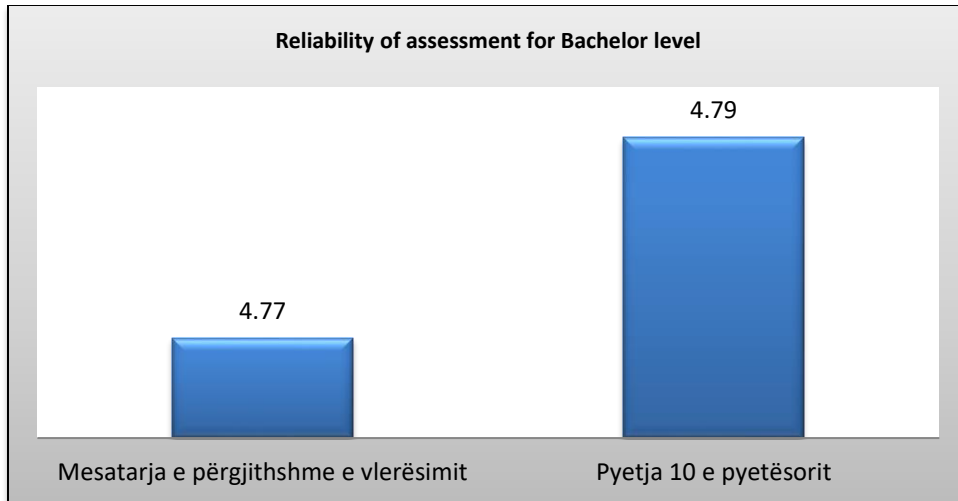

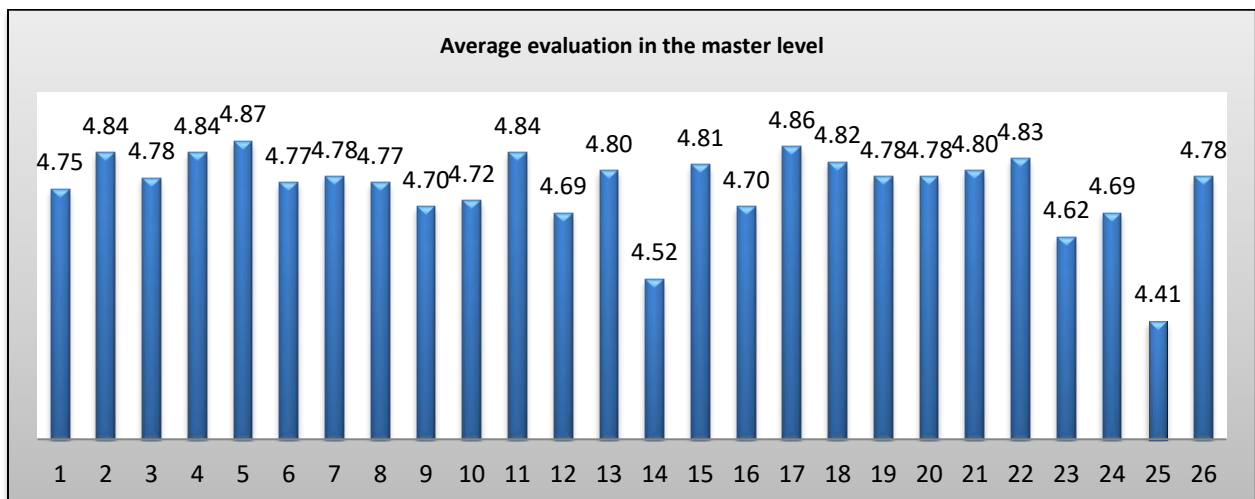
In the last pillar (pillar 10), the evaluation or impression of the students on the performance of the course in general is presented. This is done through the last question in the questionnaire, where the student is asked to evaluate the course in general (The course has been successful and useful for students) with one of the grades from 1 to 5. From this we can generate the reliability of the students' evaluation by comparing the average of the overall evaluation with the value of the question number 10.



Since the overall average of the students' assessment is 4.77 and does not differ much from the average value of question 10 which is 4.79, we can conclude that the students' assessment is reliable / significant.

From the total number of respondents in the Faculty of Islamic Studies, at the Master's level of studies, the level of compliance of students varies between 4.87 and 4.41. These values indicate a high average agreement of students on the quality of the course and teaching performance at the program level.

The average ratings of courses and teachers at the level of the Master's study program are presented below:

Clarification:

The assessment was made on the basis of questionnaires with optional choices (10 optional questions for Bachelor level and 26 questions for Master level of studies) and open questions (3 open questions). For each optional question in the questionnaire, the student had the opportunity to circle one of the options from 1 (one) to 5 (five), where it means that: (1 = do not

agree at all; 2 = disagree; 3 = neutral; 4 = agree; 5 = completely agree).

Meanwhile, in the open questions, the student had the opportunity to present his impressions as a comment, suggestion or any possible criticism.

3. Average evaluation of course and teachers for Bachelor level

The average compliance values generated by the evaluation (in the following table), such as: 4.56, 4.69 etc., represent the average ratings of the total compliance by the students for the relevant questions, the subject and the relevant professor. For example, the value 5.00 is considered as an average value which represents the student's agreement for the relevant question "The attendance of the teacher during the semester was regular", this value means that, on average in total, the students fully agree with the question posed for the subject and the relevant professor.
